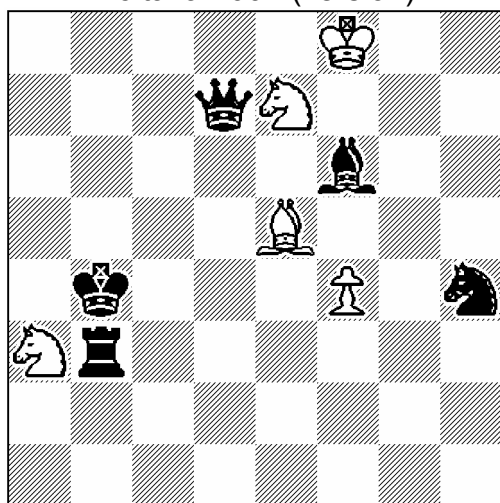

Theme: Poltava Twins – 3

H#3: The twin b) is formed by shifting the white king in such a way that the king renders impossible the solution in twin a). In the solution of b), a white long-range piece arrives on the square that was occupied by the white king in a), forming a white battery which delivers mate. Model mates are required. It is preferable that both twins feature a common theme (e.g. Bristol in example 1).

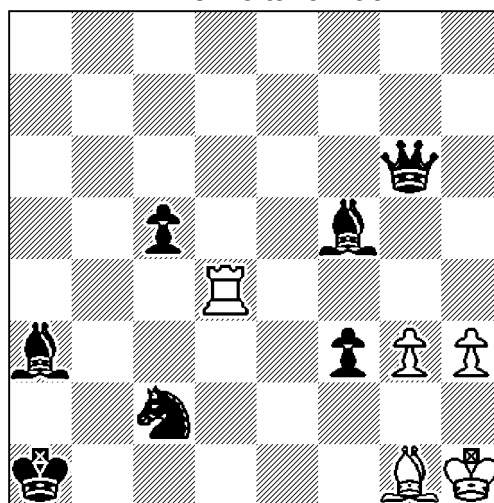
